INTRODUCTION

This workshop explains why accidents occur, the events that lead to them, how these can be recognised, and how to take pro-active steps to prevent accidents thus reducing claims and prosecutions.

It explains how to determine the basic causes of accidents and how to investigate thoroughly. And includes how to ask the questions that provide useful answers and to compare these answers with those obtained from other sources.

By identifying corrective measures and preventive controls employers also ensure that any associated corrective costs are dedicated to problem resolution. Timely reporting of a well investigated accident, under RIDDOR Regulations, often leads to the avoidance of HSE inspectorate intervention and enforcement action. By understanding where human error in accidents takes place employers are able to accurately identify employee's training needs and meet their legal obligations.
