



APPOINTED PERSON LIFTING OPERATIONS – NON CPCs – 3 DAYS



INTRODUCTION

The roles and responsibilities of all personnel involved in the planning, supervision and execution of lifting operations are defined in the code of practice BS7121 – Safe Use of Cranes. BS7121 helps employers comply with the Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations 1998 (LOLER) when they are using mobile cranes. The title and role of the Appointed Person (AP) is first introduced by BS7121 part 1 as the competent person responsible for developing a safe system of work for a lifting operation. The Appointed Person need not be an employee of the Employing Organisation, however, they must have adequate training, experience and technical knowledge to carry out the role competently.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

This course is designed for Contracts Managers, Site Managers and Assistant Site Managers who have to either plan or manage complex contract lifts. Delegates must be aware of their Company's procedures with regard to Lifting Operations.

COURSE DURATION

- Legislation and British Standards relevant to lifting operations
- Examine recent prosecutions relevant to lifting operations
- Ground conditions, services, wind etc
- Selection and use of lifting equipment
- Examination and inspections – documentation checks
- Desk top exercise to develop a Lifting Plan
- Selection of cranes, lifting gear and personnel duties
