



# OCCUPATIONAL VIBRATION

## INTRODUCTION

In July 2005 new regulations came into force to implement the EU Physical Agents (Vibration) Directive, replacing the current HSE guidance (HS(G)88) and building on the general requirement to assess and manage risk as set out in the Management of Health & Safety at Work Regulations 1999.



The new regulations include an Exposure Action Value and introduce for the first time an Exposure Limit Value, which must not be exceeded. The regulations also introduce limits on whole body vibration. These regulations may have a significant impact on businesses using a wide range of hand operated vibration tools.
